Business and Tourism meet at The Marine to discuss Service Excellence Training



Still time to register for Service Excellence free training courses

In a joint venture between the Western Cape Government, Overstrand Municipality, Overstrand Tourism and the Hermanus Business Chamber a presentation was done on 19th April 2018 at The Marine Hotel on the J2SE Project. It was started by National Department of Tourism and adopted by Western Cape Government to boost service level improvements and attractiveness of the region. This programme is open to all businesses in Hermanus - both tourism and non-tourism businesses and there is still time to register. It includes Petrol Station attendants, Banks, Retail shops, Accommodation, transport, restaurants, Motor Car dealers, Attorneys, Pharmacy's, Cafes, Restaurants, Nurseries, etc. It aims to develop a service excellence-orientated culture. The 4 – day workshop is aligned to the SABS approved SANS 1197 standards. It takes place over 2 weeks: 2 x 2 days. There are 8 groups with maximum of 25 people per group, therefore the aim is to reach 200 persons. The J2SE training will start on 18 June 2018 and continue till end August with a Leadership Workshop. Whale Coast FM will run a radio competition in August/September where the community of the Overstrand can nominate your business as a Service Hero if you provide Excellent Service. The winners will be announced at a special Awards evening to be held afterwards, and cash prizes will be awarded to those who excelled.


